Eerste schooldag

1 september 2021

January: priority for siblings of pupils and children of staff
from 4 January (8 a.m.) to 15 January 2021 (4 p.m.)

January-February: get to know the schools

Contact and or visit the school (if it's possible), surf over to the school's website, chat with other parents, etc.

March: choose the school and sign your child up via inschrijveninbrussel.be

from 1 March (9 a.m.) to 26 March 2021 (4 p.m.)

Take note: you first have to sign your child up. This is not yet a final registration.

May: find out from the email or letter which school you can register in.

Contact the school and register your child

from 3 May (8 a.m.) to 26 May 2021 (12 noon)

May: open registrations, where there is still space

from 3 June 2021

September: first day of school

1 September 2021
